6. Explain the impact of the printing process on your design.

I incorporated bleeding into my layout design by extending the final trim size by giving my document an extra 0.25 inches on all sides. This ensures any extra bleeding won't bleed into the final design as well as ensures any extra ink that bled through will be trimmed off during the trimming process after printing. Other considerations I had to make in order to make this card print ready includes understanding where the center fold would be, as well as how the pages will face when the printing process is complete. I had to switch around my pages so the first page's design, (front and back) would line up with the second page's design (middle two) correctly. The results of the preflighting document were no errors, so I didn't have to move around or fix other content. The design is print ready.
